# Chapter 1

### The Blessings of Redemption

<sup>1</sup> Paul, <sup>a</sup>an apostle of <sup>b</sup>Christ Jesus <sup>1</sup>cby the will of God.

To the <sup>2d</sup>saints who are <sup>3</sup> at <sup>e</sup>Ephesus and <sup>f</sup>are faithful in <sup>b</sup>Christ Jesus: <sup>2</sup> <sup>a</sup> Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

<sup>3a</sup>Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in bthe heavenly places in Christ, 4 just as <sup>a</sup> He chose us in Him before <sup>b</sup>the foundation of the world, that we would be choly and blameless before <sup>1</sup>Him. <sup>d</sup>In love <sup>5</sup> <sup>1</sup>He <sup>a</sup>predestined us to badoption as sons and daughters through Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, 6 ato the praise of the glory of His grace, with which He favored us in bthe Beloved . 7 aIn 1Him we have bredemption cthrough His blood, the dforgiveness of our wrongdoings, according to ethe riches of His grace <sup>8</sup> which He <sup>1</sup>lavished on <sup>2</sup> us. In all wisdom and insight 9 He <sup>1a</sup> made known to us the mystery of His will, baccording to His good pleasure which He cset forth in Him, 10 regarding His | plan of athe fullness of the times, bto bring all things together in Christ, things <sup>1</sup>in the heavens and things on the earth. <sup>11</sup> ¹In Him we also ahave 📙 obtained an inheri tance, having been b predestined caccording to the purpose of Him who works all things din accordance with the plan of His will, 12 to the end that 1 we who were the first to hope in the <sup>2</sup>Christ would be <sup>a</sup>to the praise of His glory. <sup>13</sup> In <sup>1</sup>Him, <sup>2</sup> you also, after listening to <sup>a</sup>the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation—having also <sup>3</sup>believed, you were <sup>b</sup>sealed in <sup>1</sup>Him with cthe Holy Spirit of the promise, 14 who is a afirst installment of bour inheritance, in regard to the credemption of dGod's own possession, eto the praise of His glory.

<sup>15</sup> For this reason I too, <sup>a</sup>having heard of the faith in the Lord Jesus which *exists* among you and <sup>1</sup> your love for <sup>b</sup> all the <sup>2</sup>saints, <sup>16</sup> <sup>a</sup>do not cease giving thanks for you, <sup>b</sup>while making mention *of you* in my prayers; <sup>17</sup> that the <sup>a</sup>God of our Lord Jesus Christ, <sup>b</sup>the Father of glory, may give you a spirit of <sup>c</sup>wisdom and of <sup>d</sup>revelation in the <sup>1</sup>knowledge of Him. <sup>18</sup> I pray that <sup>a</sup>the eyes of your heart <sup>1</sup>may be enlightened, so that you

will know what is the bhope of His calling, what are <sup>1</sup>the riches of the glory of <sup>e</sup>His inheri tance in fthe 2saints, 19 and what is the 1boundless greatness of His power toward - us who believe. aThese are in accordance with the working of the <sup>b</sup>strength of His might <sup>20</sup> which He brought about in Christ, when He araised Him from the dead and beseated Him at His right hand in <sup>c</sup>the heavenly *places*, <sup>21</sup> far above <sup>a</sup>all rule and authority and power and dominion, and every bname that is named, not only in cthis age but also in the one to come. <sup>22</sup> And He <sup>a</sup>put all things in subjection under His feet, and made Him bhead over all things to the church, 23 which is His abody, the bfullness of Him who cfills dall in all.

# Chapter 2

#### Made Alive in Christ

<sup>1</sup>And <sup>1</sup>you <sup>2</sup>were <sup>a</sup> dead <sup>3</sup>in your offenses and sins, <sup>2</sup> in which you <sup>a</sup>previously walked according to the <sup>1</sup>course of <sup>b</sup>this world, according to <sup>c</sup>the prince of the power of the air, of the spirit that is now working in <sup>d</sup>the <sup>2</sup>sons of disobedience. <sup>3</sup> Among them <sup>1</sup>we too all <sup>a</sup>previously lived in <sup>b</sup>the lusts of our flesh, <sup>2</sup>indulging

the desires of the flesh and of the 3mind, and were <sup>c</sup>by nature <sup>d</sup>children of wrath, <sup>e</sup> just as the rest. <sup>4</sup> But God, being <sup>a</sup>rich in mercy, because of <sup>b</sup>His great love with which He loved us, <sup>5</sup> even when we were adead in our wrongdoings, made us alive together <sup>2</sup>with Christ (<sup>b</sup>by grace you have been saved), 6 and araised us up with Him, and bseated us with Him in cthe heavenly places in dChrist Jesus, 7 so that in the ages to come He might show the ¹boundless ³riches of His grace in bkindness toward us in Christ Jesus. 8 For aby grace you have been saved bthrough faith; and 1this is not of yourselves, it is 6the gift of God; 9 a **not a result of works**, so that bno one may boast. 10 For we are His workmanship, acreated in **bChrist Jesus for**  good works, which God dprepared beforehand so that we would walk in them.

Christ. <sup>14</sup> For He Himself is <sup>a</sup>our peace, <sup>b</sup> who made both groups into one and broke down the <sup>1</sup>barrier of the dividing wall, <sup>15</sup> <sup>1</sup>by <sup>a</sup>abolishing <sup>2</sup>in His flesh the hostility, which is by the Law composed of commandments expressed in ordinances, so that in Himself He might <sup>3c</sup>make the two <sup>d</sup>one new person, <u>in this waw</u> establishing <sup>e</sup>peace; <sup>16</sup> and that He might <sup>a</sup>reconcile them both in bone body to God through the cross, by it having cput to death the hostility. 17 AND AHE CAME AND PREACHED BPEACE TO YOU WHO WERE CFAR AWAY, AND PEACE TO THOSE WHO WERE CNEAR; 18 for through Him we both have aour access in bone Spirit to cthe Father. 19 So then you are no longer <sup>a</sup>strangers and foreigners, but you are <sup>b</sup>fellow with the <sup>1</sup>saints, and are of <sup>c</sup>God's citizens household, 20 having been a built on bthe foundation of c the apostles and prophets, dChrist Jesus Himself being the ecornerstone, 21 ain whom the whole building, being fitted together, is growing into ba holy temple in the Lord, 22 in whom you also are being abuilt together into a <sup>b</sup>dwelling of God in the Spirit.

# Chapter 3

### Paul's Stewardship

<sup>1</sup>For this reason I, Paul, <sup>a</sup>the prisoner of <sup>b</sup>Christ Jesus <sup>c</sup> for the sake of you <sup>d</sup>Gentiles —<sup>2</sup> if

indeed you have heard of the administration of God's grace which was given to me for you; 3 athat bby revelation there was cmade known to me d the mystery, eas I wrote before briefly. 4 <sup>1</sup>By referring to this, when you read you can understand amy insight 2into the bmystery of Christ, 5 which in other generations was not made known to <sup>1</sup>mankind, as it has now been revealed to His holy apostles and prophets 2 in the Spirit; <sup>6</sup> to be specific, that the Gentiles are <sup>a</sup>fellow heirs and <sup>b</sup>fellow members of the body, and <sup>c</sup>fellow partakers of the promise in <sup>d</sup>Christ Jesus through the gospel, <sup>7 a</sup>of which I was made a <sup>b</sup>minister, according to the gift of <sup>c</sup>God's grace which was given to me daccording to the working of His power. 8 To me, athe very least of all <sup>1</sup>saints, this grace was given, to <sup>b</sup>preach to the Gentiles the unfathomable <sup>c</sup>riches of Christ, 9 and to <sup>1</sup>enlighten all people as to what the plan of the amystery is which for ages has been <sup>b</sup>hidden in God, <sup>c</sup>who created all things; <sup>10</sup> so that the multifaceted awisdom of God might now be <sup>b</sup>made known through the church to the <sup>c</sup>rulers and the authorities in <sup>d</sup>the heavenly *places*. <sup>11</sup> This was in accordance with the beternal purpose which He <sup>2</sup>carried out in <sup>b</sup>Christ Jesus our Lord, <sup>12</sup> in whom we have boldness and <sup>1a</sup>confident baccess through faith 2in Him. 13 Therefore I ask

14 For this reason I abend my knees before the Father, 15 from whom levery family in heaven and on earth derives its name, 16 that He would grant you, according to athe riches of His glory, to be bstrengthened with power through His Spirit in the inner leelf, 17 so that aChrist may dwell in your hearts through faith; and that you, being brooted and grounded in love, 18 may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is bthe width and length and height and depth, 19 and to know athe love of Christ which bsurpasses knowledge, that you may be filled to all the dfullness of God.

<sup>20</sup> aNow to Him who is <sup>b</sup>able to do far more abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, <sup>c</sup>according to the power that works within us, <sup>21</sup> ato Him *be* the glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all generations <sup>1</sup> forever and ever. Amen.

# Chapter 4

### Unity of the Spirit

Therefore I, a the prisoner of the Lord, burge you to cwalk in a manner worthy of the dcalling with which you have been ecalled, with all ahumility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another bin love, being diligent to keep the unity of the Spirit in the abond of peace.

There is <sup>a</sup> 1. one body and 1. one Spirit, just as you also were called in 3. one <sup>b</sup>hope of your calling; <sup>5</sup> <sup>a</sup> 4. one Lord, 5. one faith, 6. one baptism, <sup>6</sup> 7. one God and Father of all <sup>a</sup>who is over all and through all and in all.

<sup>7</sup> But <sup>a</sup> to each one of us <sup>b</sup> grace was given <sup>c</sup>according to the measure of Christ's gift. <sup>8</sup> Therefore <sup>1</sup>it says,

"aWhen He ascended on high, HE bled captive *THE* captives, AND HE GAVE GIFTS TO PEOPLE."

9 (Now this expression, "He ascended," what <sup>1</sup>does it mean except that He also <sup>2</sup>had descended into bthe lower parts of the earth? 10 He who descended is Himself also He who ascended afar above all the heavens, so that He might bfill all things.) <sup>11</sup> And He <sup>a</sup>gave <sup>b</sup>some as apostles, some as prophets, some as <sup>c</sup>evangelists, some as <sup>1</sup>pastors and <sup>d</sup>teachers, <sup>12</sup> <sup>a</sup>for the equipping of the 'saints for the work of ministry, for the building up of bthe body of Christ; 13 until we all attain to athe unity of the faith, and of the <sup>1b</sup>knowledge of the Son of God, to a <sup>c</sup>mature man, to the measure of the stature <sup>2</sup>which belongs to the <sup>d</sup>fullness of Christ. <sup>14</sup> <sup>1</sup> As a result, we are ano longer to be children, btossed here and there by waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of people, by <sup>c</sup>craftiness <sup>2</sup>in <sup>d</sup>deceitful scheming; <sup>15</sup> but <sup>1</sup>speaking the truth <sup>a</sup>in love, <sup>2</sup>we are to <sup>b</sup>grow

up in all *aspects* into Him who is the <sup>c</sup>head, *that is*, Christ, <sup>16</sup> from whom <sup>a</sup>the whole body, being fitted and held together <sup>1</sup>by what every joint supplies, according to the <sup>2</sup>proper working of each individual part, causes the growth of the body for the building up of itself <sup>b</sup>in love.

#### The Christian's Walk

<sup>17</sup> <sup>a</sup>So I say this, and affirm in the Lord, <sup>b</sup>that you are to no longer walk just as the 'Gentiles also walk, in the <sup>c</sup> futility of their minds, <sup>18</sup> being <sup>a</sup> adarkened in their understanding, <sup>1b</sup> 3 excluded from the life of God because of the cignorance that is in them, because of the d hardness of their heart; 19 and they, having abecome callous, bhave given themselves up to cindecent behavior 1 for the practice of every kind of impurity with greediness. 20 But you did not alearn Christ in this way, 21 if indeed you ahave heard Him and have been taught in Him, just as truth is in Jesus, 22 that, in reference to pyour former way of life, you are to arid yourselves of the bold 1self, which is being corrupted in accordance with the clusts of deceit, 23 and that you are to be arenewed in the spirit of your minds, 24 and to aput on the bnew self, which acin the likeness of God has been created in righteousness and holiness of the truth.

<sup>25</sup>Therefore, <sup>a</sup>ridding yourselves of falsehood, bspeak truth each one of you with his neighbor, because we are cparts of one another. 26 aBE ANGRY, AND yet DO NOT SIN; do not let the sun go down on your anger, <sup>27</sup> and do not <sup>a</sup>give the devil <sup>1</sup>an opportunity. <sup>28</sup> The one who steals must no longer steal; but rather ahe must labor, <sup>b</sup>producing with his own hands what is good, <sup>c</sup>so that he will have something to share with the one who has need. <sup>29</sup> Let no <sup>1a</sup>unwholesome word come out of your mouth, but if there is any good word for bedification 2 according to the need of the moment, say that, so that it will give grace to those who hear. 30 a Do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, ¹by whom you were ¹b sealed for the day of redemption. 31 aAll bitterness, wrath, anger, ¹clamor, and slander must be bremoved from you, along with all cmalice. 32 aBe kind to one another, compassionate, forgiving each other, bjust as God in Christ also has forgiven you.

# Chapter 5

### Be Imitators of God

<sup>1a</sup>Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children; <sup>2</sup> and <sup>a</sup>walk in love, just as Christ also <sup>b</sup>loved <sup>1</sup>you and <sup>c</sup>gave Himself up for us, an <sup>d</sup>offering and a sacrifice to God <sup>2</sup>as a <sup>e</sup>fragrant aroma.

<sup>3</sup> But <sup>a</sup>sexual immorality <sup>1</sup> or any impurity or greed must not even be mentioned among you, as is proper among <sup>2</sup> saints; <sup>4</sup> and *there must be no* <sup>a</sup>filthiness <sup>1</sup> or foolish talk, or vulgar joking, which <sup>b</sup> are not fitting, but rather <sup>c</sup> giving of thanks. <sup>5</sup> For this you know with certainty, that <sup>a</sup> no sexually immoral or <sup>1</sup> impure or greedy person, which <sup>2</sup> amounts to an idolater, has an inheritance in the kingdom <sup>b</sup> of Christ and God.

<sup>6</sup> a See that no one deceives you with empty words, for because of these things bthe wrath of God comes upon cthe sons of disobedience. 7 Therefore do not become apartners with them; 8 for <sup>a</sup>you were once <sup>b</sup>darkness, but now you are light in the Lord; walk as children of light 9 (for athe fruit of the light consists in all bgoodness, righteousness, and truth), 10 12 as you try to learn what is pleasing to the Lord. 11 aDo not participate in the useless bdeeds of cdarkness, but instead even dexpose them; 12 for it is disgraceful even to speak of the things which are done by them in secret. 13 But all things become visible awhen they are exposed by the light, for everything that becomes visible is light. 14 For this reason it says,

"aAwake, sleeper,
And arise from bthe dead,
And Christ cwill shine on you."

<sup>15</sup> So then, <sup>1</sup>be careful how you <sup>a</sup>walk, not <sup>b</sup>as

unwise people but as wise, <sup>16</sup> <sup>1a</sup>making the most of your time, because <sup>b</sup>the days are evil. <sup>17</sup> Therefore do not be foolish, but <sup>a</sup>understand what the will of the Lord *is*. <sup>18</sup> And <sup>a</sup>do not get drunk with wine, <sup>1</sup>in which there is <sup>b</sup>debauchery, but be <sup>c</sup>filled with the Spirit, <sup>19</sup> <sup>a</sup>speaking to <sup>1</sup>one another in <sup>b</sup>psalms and <sup>c</sup>hymns and spiritual <sup>d</sup>songs, <sup>e</sup>singing and making melody with your hearts to the Lord; <sup>20</sup> <sup>a</sup>always giving thanks for all things in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to *our* <sup>b</sup>God and Father; <sup>21</sup> <sup>1a</sup>and subject yourselves to one another in the <sup>2b</sup>fear of Christ.

### Marriage like Christ and the Church

<sup>22</sup> <sup>a</sup>Wives, <sup>b</sup> subject yourselves to your own husbands, <sup>c</sup> as to the Lord. <sup>23</sup> For <sup>a</sup> the husband is the head of the wife, as Christ also is the <sup>b</sup> head of the church, He Himself <sup>c</sup> being the Savior of the body. <sup>24</sup> But as the church is subject to Christ, so also the wives *ought to be* to their husbands in everything.

<sup>25 a</sup>Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and <sup>b</sup>gave Himself up for her, <sup>26</sup> <sup>a</sup>so that He might sanctify her, having <sup>b</sup>cleansed her by the <sup>c</sup>washing of water with <sup>d</sup>the word, <sup>27</sup> that He might <sup>a</sup>present to Himself the church <sup>1</sup>in all her glory, having no spot or wrinkle or any such thing; but that she would be <sup>b</sup>holy and blameless. <sup>28</sup> So husbands also ought to <sup>a</sup>love their own wives as their own bodies. He who loves his own wife loves himself; <sup>29</sup> for no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as Christ also *does* the church, <sup>30</sup> because we are <sup>a</sup>parts of His <sup>b</sup>body. <sup>31</sup> <sup>a</sup>For This

REASON A MAN SHALL LEAVE HIS FATHER AND HIS MOTHER AND BE JOINED TO HIS WIFE, AND THE TWO SHALL BECOME ONE FLESH. 32 This mystery is great; but I am speaking with reference to Christ and the church. 33 Nevertheless, as for you individually, each husband is to alove his own wife the same as himself, and the wife must see to it that she <sup>b</sup>respects her husband.

# Chapter 6

#### Children and Parents

4 a Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.

### Slaves and Masters

5aSlaves, be obedient to those who are your <sup>1</sup>masters according to the flesh, with <sup>b</sup>fear and trembling, in the sincerity of your heart, cas to Christ; <sup>6</sup> anot <sup>1</sup>by way of <sup>2</sup>eye-service, as <sup>b</sup>peoplepleasers, but as <sup>c</sup>slaves of Christ, <sup>d</sup>doing the will of God from the 3heart. 7 With goodwill 1render service, aas to the Lord, and not to people, 8 aknowing that bwhatever good thing each one does, he will receive this back from the Lord,

<sup>c</sup>whether slave or free.

<sup>9</sup> And masters, do the same things to them, and <sup>a</sup>give up threatening, knowing that <sup>b</sup>both their Master and yours is in heaven, and there is <sup>c</sup>no partiality with Him.

### The Armor of God

Finally, abe strong in the Lord and in bthe strength of His might. 11 aPut on the full armor of God, so that you will be able to stand firm against the <sup>b</sup>schemes of the devil. <sup>12</sup> For our <sup>a</sup>struggle is not against <sup>1b</sup>flesh and blood, but <sup>c</sup>against the rulers, against the powers, against the dworld forces of this edarkness, against the fspiritual forces of wickedness in gthe heavenly places. 13 Therefore, take up 3 the full armor of God, so that you will be able to bresist on othe evil day, and having done everything, to stand firm. <sup>14</sup> Stand firm therefore, <sup>3</sup> HAVING **1** BELTED YOUR WAIST WITH TRUTH, AND HAVING BPUT ON THE BREASTPLATE OF RIGHTEOUSNESS, 15 and having <sup>a</sup> **3** F STRAPPED ON YOUR FEET THE PREPARATION OF The gospel of peace;  $^{16}$  in addition to all, taking up the <sup>a</sup> 4 shield of faith with which you will be able to extinguish all the bflaming arrows of cthe evil one. 17 And take a 5 THE HELMET OF SALVA-TION and the <sup>b</sup> 6 sword of the Spirit, which is cthe word of God. <sup>18</sup> With every <sup>a</sup>prayer and request, <sup>2b</sup>pray at all times cin the Spirit, and with this in view, 3dbe

alert with all eperseverance and every frequest for all the 4saints, 19 and apray in my behalf, that
