






Where Are the TOMBS OF THE KINGS?

This infographic shows Jerusalem in the fifth century B.C.E., the time period of Ezra and Nehemiah. The city had been destroyed by the Babylonians in 586 B.C.E. The Jews returned from exile in the late sixth century and, under the leadership of Zerubbabel and Joshua, laid the foundations of the altar and the temple. During the time of Ezra and Nehemiah, the wall around Jerusalem was reconstructed. The construction of this wall, including the situation of specific gates and even the location of the "sepulchre of David," is recorded in detail in Nehemiah 3.
