Sacred Tree



Tiglath-Pileser III 745 BCE-727 BCE










"In my former campaigns I considered all the cities... that I carried away as booty and... the place of Samaria only did I leave their king."






Tiglath-Pileser III's Summary Inscription Four

"Israel [literally, Omri-land Bit-Humria]... All its inhabitants (and) their possessions I led to Assyria. They overthrew their king Pekah and I placed Hoshea as king over them. I received from them 10 talents of gold, 1,000 (?) talents of silver as their [tri]bute and brought them to Assyria."

Tiglath-Pileser III's Summary Inscription Seven

"From these I received tribute ... Jehoahaz [Ahaz] of Judah... including gold, silver, iron, fine cloth and many garments made from wool that was dyed in purple ... as well as all kinds of lavish gifts from many nations and from the kings that rule over them."



Sargon II's Inscribed Prism

"The inhabitants of Samaria ... I fought against them ... I settled ... them in the midst of Assyria. I repopulated Samaria more than before. I brought into it people from countries conquered by my hands"
